

## DOORS

### Series 08/13 Doors

1. Door call sizes reflect the height measurement by the width measurement of the rough opening.
2. Outer frames of doors (Fig. 1A) are undersized by  $\frac{1}{8}$ " for the height and  $\frac{1}{8}$ " on the width.
3. Inner Frames (Fig. 1B) are undersized by 1" for the height and  $\frac{7}{8}$ " for the width.

**Example:**

Door (Call Size) - 32 x 42 - (32" Height x 42" Width)

Backside of outer frame (Fig. 1A) will measure:  $31 \frac{7}{8}$ " x  $41 \frac{7}{8}$ "

The inner door frame (Fig. 1B) will measure : 31" x 41  $\frac{1}{8}$ "

### All other Series Doors

1. Door call sizes reflect the height measurement by the width measurement of the rough opening.
2. Outer frames of doors (Fig. 1A) are undersized by  $\frac{1}{4}$ " for the height and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the width.
3. Inner Frames (Fig. 1B) are undersized by  $\frac{5}{8}$ " for the height and  $\frac{5}{8}$ " for the width.

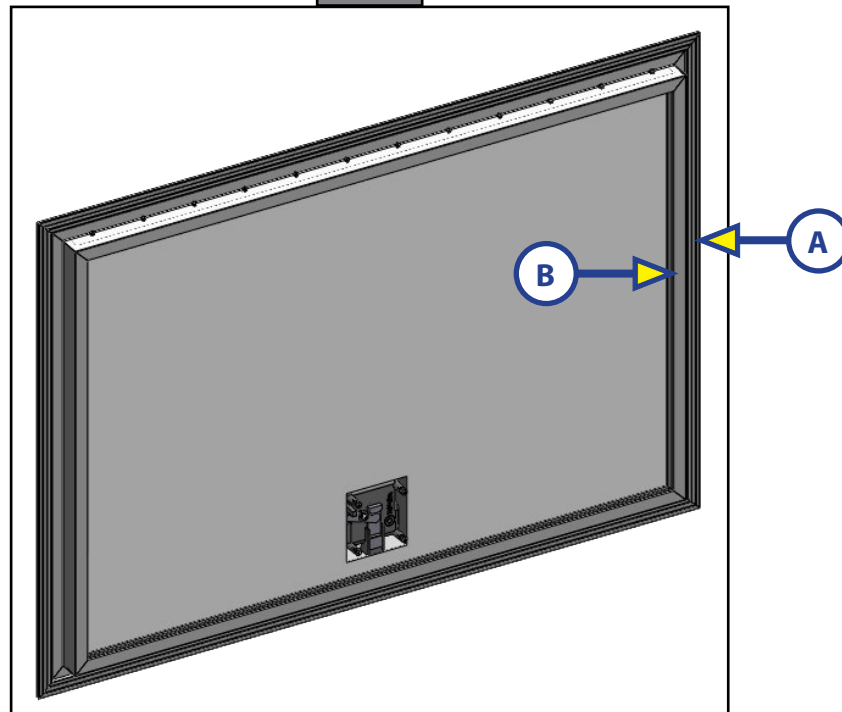
**Example:**

Door (Call Size) - 32 x 42 - (32" Height x 42" Width)

Backside of outer frame (Fig. 1A) will measure:  $31 \frac{3}{4}$ " x  $41 \frac{3}{4}$ "

The inner door frame (Fig. 1B) will measure :  $31 \frac{3}{8}$ " x  $41 \frac{3}{8}$ "
